Sri Lanka

There are 276 Friendship Force clubs around the world in 49 countries, but when we look at this list of 38 countries whose 213 clubs offered to host

next year and see how many requests each received, it is easy to recognize the "hotspots" - the places that are reliably oversubscribed, year after year. Equally deserving of our attention, though, are those countries who are undersubscribed for journeys. In a world filled with well-known destinations, it is vital to look beyond the familiar and discover the hidden treasures that often go unnoticed.

There are now two active Friendship Force clubs in Sri Lanka, FF Galle and FF Ambalangoda, both on the southwest coast. Three more Sri Lankan clubs are under development, promising a varied cultural exchange program for visiting ambassadors to a country that is new to Friendship Force.

Family values play a significant role in Sri Lankan society, and this emphasis on close-knit relationships extends to Sri Lankans' interactions with outsiders. Visitors are treated as honored guests and Sri Lankans are famously enthusiastic about sharing stories and providing insights into their way of life.
